The purpose of this meeting is to present a project update on the Kenneth F. Burns Memorial Bridge Replacement project. The evaluation is being performed as part of the environmental process in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the Massachusetts Environmental Policy Act (MEPA). Following the presentation, MassDOT staff will lead a discussion to answer questions and gather public comments. Comments received will be carefully considered to the extent possible as the project moves forward.

The replacement of the Kenneth F. Burns Memorial Bridge, which carries Route 9 over Lake Quinsigamond between Worcester and Shrewsbury, is being funded under the Patrick-Murray Accelerated Bridge Program (ABP). This project is one of the most significant projects being undertaken by MassDOT under the ABP and when completed, will create a replacement bridge that meets the needs of all the users of the bridge.
